MOBILE HOME PARK RESIDENTS

Dismantled or Destroyed

If you have dismantled or destroyed your Mobile Home in Manatee County, go to www.taxcollector.com click on CONTACT US, then click on Contact us by e-mail then select Mobile Home from the drop down menu in the search by category. Click on search, and scroll down to view your results.

Decal Renewal Period

The registration period for Mobile Homes is January 1st through December 31st: the annual expiration date is December 31st. It is the responsibility of the Mobile Home owner to renew their decal(s). When renewing decals, if you have a single wide Mobile Home you will be issued one decal. In the case of a double or triple wide mobile home, one decal will be issued per side. These are affixed to one "master" backing decal, the color of which is based on a four year rotation.

Displaying Decals

Decals are to be displayed in the lower left hand corner of the window closest to the street or road which provides access to the Mobile Home. Decals are to be visible at all times and are not to be covered by awnings, shutters, foliage, etc.
